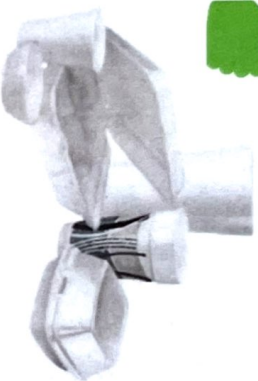

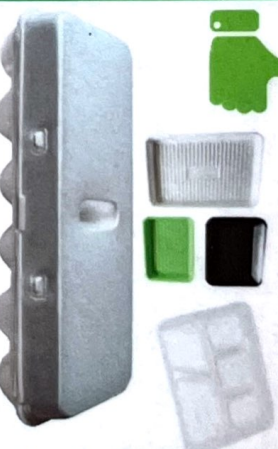

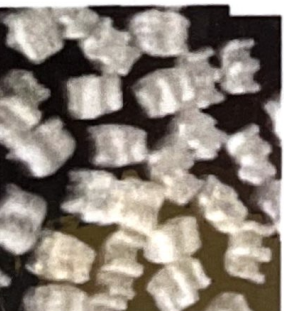

## Clean + Dry + Loose

## Glass Bottles & Jars

**Clear & Colored; Food or Beverage**

**CLEAN.**

Labels are OK!

Remove metal  
lids.



## Plastic Bottles, Jugs, & Tubs

**Rigid plastics only. NO FOAM.**

Labels are OK.

**Rinse & keep cap on.**



**Paper, Magazines, & Newsprint**

Remove plastic & rubber bands.  
Shred in clear bags.

## Metal Cans & Foil



CLEAN.

Labels are OK.

## Aerosol cans

**MUST be empty!**

**NEW!** Cartons

Coated paper-board that held liquid: milk, juice, creamer, broth, etc.

*Keep Caps On!*



## Plastic Shopping Bags

Stuff bags inside another bag and tie shut.



**DO NOT PLACE IN BIN**



•Anything dirty
